<u>"ROUGH DRAFT"</u> <u>Time line for</u> <u>PROM DAY!</u>

1:30ish Parksville Beach *This is optional <u>NOT mandatory!</u> This is a tradition the grads look forward to doing. They go down to the beach with their families and friends to take pictures.

2:30 Parksville Beach at the gazebo we have a photographer who will be taking a group photo of all the grads who are down at the beach at this time.

3:00 Springwood School -Marshalling for the Parade- *This too is optional, if your grad chooses not to be in the parade or walk the red carpet they can arrive at the PCCC and head to the main entrance. Doors will open at 5:00

5:00 Parade starts!

5:15 First grads should start arriving on the red carpet where their name will be announced.

Upon arriving they will go through security, <u>PARENTS PLEASE</u> take a moment and remind your grad <u>THIS IS A DRUG AND ALCOHOL FREE EVENT!</u> There will be a <u>ZERO</u> <u>TOLERANCE POLICY</u> in place the day of this event! If anyone is found to be under the influence, or in possession of either drugs or alcohol they will be asked to leave immediately! They will not be eligible for a refund! Their parent or guardian at this point will be contacted and asked to come and pick up their grad immediately! This rule applies for any date who may be accompanying a grad. There <u>WILL BE</u> a police presence at this event!!! Upon entering, the grads will be able to mingle around the building with their friends as the rest of the parade arrives. Once everyone is in the building the main doors to the venue will open and they will all be seated at tables where dinner will be served.

6:50 A quick announcement will be made to explain to the grads how the evening will unfold.

7:00 Dinner will be served.

8:15 King and Queen will be announced *This is a quick game were a small prize will be given to the King and Queen of the evening.

8:30 The dance will begin.

9:00 Doors will open and the grads are free to move around at this point and check out all the fun things that have been planned for them. At this time anyone wanting to change out of their formal wear may do so, <u>but only up until 10:30.</u> Just a reminder <u>THIS IS A FORMAL</u> <u>EVENT!!! We do encourage grads to stay in their formal wear, but understand this may not be right for everyone.</u>

More information will follow closer to the event

11:00-12:00 In the main venue area there will be entertainment on stage.

12:00 Midnight snack will be served along with Prizes!

12:00*Cleanup will begin in the outer rooms of the building.

12:30-1:30 In the main venue area there will be more entertainment on stage.

1:45 GRAND PRIZE WILL BE DRAWN!!! Grad must be present to win.

2:00 Grads will exit. As they exit they will receive a parting gift. (**This is for grads only not dates.**)

At any point in the evening if your grad chooses to leave, he or she may do so by having a parent or guardian sign them out. Any grad, who signs out **prior** to the prizes being drawn, will **NOT BE** eligible to receive a prize regardless of whether or not his/her name is drawn. They must be present to receive a prize!

Parents will <u>NOT</u> be allowed to enter the venue during prom night. This is for grads only! However, we will need parent volunteers for the night to pull this off! If you are available to help out during the evening we have sign-up sheets available with different jobs and time slots throughout the evening. <u>ALL volunteers must go through security</u>, and sign in and out during the prom.
