Re: Nanaimo Airport Commission (NAC) Scholarships and Awards

In keeping with the NAC's mandate to be inclusive of all stakeholders within its service area, we have established the Nanaimo Airport Scholarship program. Scholarships will be offered to all secondary school students within our service area in the Central Vancouver Island region. Students who are planning to actively pursue studies in eligible fields listed here are encouraged to apply. One scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a student in each of School Districts 68, 69, 70, and 79.

Students who meet the eligibility criteria and wish to apply for this scholarship are asked to submit a 500 - 1000 word essay in a subject specific to their intended area of study. The NAC Scholarship Committee will review all submissions to select the successful candidates. Once the student scholarship application deadline is reached, we would like to receive applications for the NAC scholarship no later than **April 15, 2019**. Each School District will be made aware of the awards as soon as possible after applications are reviewed by our Committee.

Eligibility:

NAC Scholarships are open to candidates who intend to pursue full-time study in a post-secondary institution. Eligible areas of study include:

- Commercial or private pilot
- Aviation maintenance
- Airport operations – Airside and/or within an airport service industry
- Business Administration or Tourism programs

The successful candidates will be expected to show proof of their enrollment in an eligible post-secondary program before receiving their scholarship funds.
