Award of Excellence 2019

A scholarship in the amount of \$5,000 awarded to a graduating high school student from an SD69 Qualicum public school going directly to an accredited Canadian Post-Secondary Institution in the school year following his/her graduation.

SD69 – Qualicum Secondary Schools are asked to submit completed applications for up to three qualified students for consideration by a District selection committee. A shortlist of applications will be provided to the foundation for final selection.

Criteria

- Demonstrated excellence as a learner
- Demonstrated commitment to community service or volunteer work
- Contribution to the culture and fabric of the school through active participation in Arts, Athletics, Leadership or Service
- Parents and student must be ordinarily resident in British Columbia as per SD69 student registration process
- Must be going directly to an accredited Canadian Post-Secondary Institution in the school year following his/her graduation

Application to include

- Cover letter from the student
- Transcript of grades through to the end of semester one of the graduation year with a listing of courses for semester two (if applicable)
- Reference letter from the school principal or grade 12 counsellor
- Completed **student profile**
- Letters of recommendation or certificates supporting completion of community or volunteer service

Details

- The name of the award winner will be provided to his/her school for announcement at the school's commencement ceremony
- The winner of the award and his/her family will be invited to attend a brief reception and media event with Pieter de Reuver Foundation Board members to be presented with the award in June
- Completed application packages being put forward by each school must be submitted to the office of the Superintendent of Schools for consideration not later than April 4, 2019
