



Aquatic Leadership Program

The Aquatic Leadership Program is designed to provide up to 10 eligible Grade 11/12 students with comprehensive training in Aquatic and Recreational Leadership. The aquatic training will amount to a minimum of 2 courses of graduation credits at the Grade 12 level (with options for a 3rd). The program schedule includes Monday and Wednesday afternoons and a rotating ½ day Friday every week (always C/D blocks) at Ravensong Aquatic Centre, where water-based instruction and training occurs. In addition there are Tuesday and Thursday mornings every week at the home school where other program requirements are fulfilled. Some students participating in this program may take an additional academic online course to be completed in the morning support-block sessions in the home school. Students will be required to pay a portion of the certification fees costs.

Aquatic Certification Courses to Include

- Bronze Medallion/Bronze Cross
- National Lifeguard Training
- Water Safety Instructor Certification
- Standard First Aid (with CPR-C)
- Aquatics Work Experience
- Recreation Leadership training
