



DANCE FOCUS EDUCATION PROGRAM

This program is designed to accommodate the schedules of intensive dancers that require a number of hours to pursue their passion while gaining school credit for a number of activities they complete in this field. This is NOT a school district program or academy, but rather a way that school district 69 can provide educational support for students in this field while working in a cooperative manner with local dance schools and studios.

This program can accommodate students from Grade 8 to Grade 12, and will use a combination of standard “bricks and mortar” school scheduling with CEAP’s distributed learning courses. Hours spent in dance-related activities can be used as partial credit for a number of course credits depending upon the grade. The tentative schedule (depending on dance school timetables) will see attendance at the dance school of choice on M/W/F afternoons, and attendance in the CEAP classrooms on T/Th mornings. The dance and dance education hours can amount to a minimum of 2 course credits. The CEAP school hours can account for 2 more course credits of choice.

Dance-related courses and suggested CEAP courses at each grade can include
