## Service Provider Payment and Internet Reimbursement Deadlines

Please be informed that we have now passed the May 28<sup>th</sup> deadline (posted on the program calendar, handbook and in previous messages to parents) for the submission for reimbursement to service providers and for Internet. If you wish further information on this, please contact the program Vice-Principal.



### Resource Return Procedures

*The following conditions apply, in addition to all others stated in the program handbook.*

#### ***For students already registered for next year at CEAP:***

- Return all textbooks and borrowed learning resources to the program office on the day of your portfolio review, the day of your secondary final exam, or by June 18.
- If in possession of a rented computer, DO NOT RETURN unless you wish to end the rental agreement, otherwise keep over the summer for use next year (No rent charged for July/August).
- CEAP will hold onto all resource and technology deposits in lieu of asking for them again next year.
- Internet supplements will be mailed with report cards upon return of all resources

#### ***For students NOT registered next year at CEAP:***

- Return all textbooks and borrowed learning resources, by June 18, to the program office, or to Ballenas or Kwalikum Secondary Schools, in the case of high school students.
- High school students may keep textbooks until the day of their final exam, when they should return them to the program office.
- Return rented computer to the program office.
- Apply for resource deposit return using the form (attached) available in the CEAP office and on the website. Deposits will be returned in July, after resource returns are confirmed.

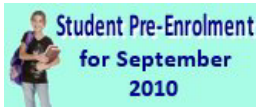
## Summer Office Hours – Clerical and Teaching Staff

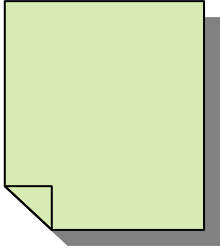
