School District 69 Threats to School and Worksite Safety

Three Levels of Response to Threat...

- Shelter in Place Free movement within the building windows and exterior doors closed and locked - staff and students remain inside until advised by authorities that conditions are safe
 - Weather event wind storm
 - Environmental event chemical spill
 - Dangerous wildlife cougar/bear sighting
 - Missing child
 - Any situation where evacuation may pose a greater risk to staff and student safety than simply remaining in the building
- Hold and Secure All exterior doors are locked and monitored allowing students from outside to enter – classes may continue to function normally – additional directions may need to be provided regarding class changes or fire alarms - staff and students remain inside until advised by authorities that conditions are safe
 - Criminal event in proximity to a school or worksite
 - Police pursuit of suspects in the vicinity of the school or worksite
 - Unstable or potentially violent person suspected to be en route to the school or worksite
- 3. Lockdown All staff and students proceed to nearest shelter area close, lock and barricade all classroom doors shut off lights and cover windows to prevent any view into the room ignore bells remain silent and avoid cellphone use remain in lockdown until the shelter area is cleared by authorities exterior doors remain as is at the time of the lockdown
 - Dangerous intruder
 - Active shooter
 - Barricaded suspect
