\$30	<p><b>Sequoia giganteum - “Giant Sequoia” - 60 cm + plant</b></p> <p>Giant sequoias are one of the world's largest and hardiest trees. Their thick bark makes them flame-resistant and resistant to fungal rot and wood-boring beetles. They can live over 3000 years.</p>
\$20	<p><b>Pseudotsuga menziesii - “Doug Fir” - ts’sey’ - 60cm + plant</b></p> <p>Douglas firs produce seeds in cones rather than flowers. The seeds have a single wing and are dispersed by wind. Douglas fir seeds feed several small mammals, including chipmunks, mice, shrews, and red squirrels. They are important for reforestation along the Pacific coast and can live for over 1000 years.</p>
\$20	<p><b>Abies amabilis - “Pacific Silver Fir” - stth'ux t'a'hw - 45 cm + plant</b></p> <p>The dense growth of Pacific silver fir provides cover and protection during the winter for wildlife. They will live up to 400 years.</p>

**These trees will happily live in their pots for a few years and thrive once planted in the ground.**
