**BOARD OF EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS**

**Purpose**

The Board of Education believes that encouraging the pursuit of excellence in all areas of student learning is an integral part of its role. To that end, District staff will set aside not less than \$5,000 annually to be granted as Board of Education scholarships to be distributed among the District's three secondary schools and Distributed Learning Program.

Board of Education Scholarships are intended to be awarded to students who:

- continually strive to demonstrate success;
- are active participants in school activities and/or the local community; and,
- are well-rounded individuals.

**Process**

A Board of Education Scholarship Committee will be established consisting of two Trustees (one of whom will chair the committee), the Superintendent or designate, the Secretary-Treasurer or designate, and an elementary school Principal/Vice Principal.

The Board of Education Scholarship Committee will review a short list of applicants from each school as determined by each school's scholarship committee.

The Board of Education Scholarship Committee will then interview applicants and recommend recipients to the Board of Education for approval.

Board of Education Scholarships will be awarded at each school's Commencement Ceremony.
