BOARD POLICY 4007

SCHOOL BUS DISPOSAL

POLICY

The Board of Education believes that surplus school buses should be disposed of in the most economically advantageous manner possible.

REGULATIONS

1. Whenever possible, surplus school buses shall be traded to bus dealers, provided the trade price is deemed by the Transportation Manager to be of fair market value.
2. Only if a surplus school bus cannot be traded to bus dealers, any alternating flashing lamps and any stop arm fitted to the school bus must be removed and all school district identification, any School Bus lettering and the warning signs associated with the alternating flashing shall be removed prior to any surplus school bus being offered for public tender.
