STUDENT PROMOTION/PLACEMENT

POLICY

The Board of Education believes that the promotion/placement of any student should be based on the judgement of what is best for the student, considering his/her intellectual, social, physical and emotional needs; and take into account the fact that effective education requires the presence of continuous and appropriate challenge to stimulate interest, effort and achievement in keeping with the student's ability.

REGULATIONS

1. The principals of each school shall establish appropriate promotion/placement policies and procedures consistent with provincial and district guidelines and requirements.
2. The principal should ensure that parents of students who may be at risk are familiar with the promotion/placement policies and procedures at the school.
3. Promotion/placement in secondary school should be by course.
4. Retention of students or placement of students, in modified classes or special education programmes, shall be made only after consultation with parents.
5. Promotion/placement in secondary schools should be by course.
