ELECTOR REGISTRATION

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the School District 69 (Qualicum) the day of registration at time of voting
- not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law

Resident electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature).

Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) and provide a copy of land title registration or tax notice which provides proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property. If the property for which you are registering to vote is owned by more than one owner the written consent of the majority of the owners must be presented at time of registration. Non-resident property electors can only vote once, regardless of the number of properties they own in the relevant voting area. As well, under Provincial legislation, corporate property owners do not have the right to vote in local government elections.

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. To register you must meet the following qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the School District 69 (Qualicum) the day of registration at time of voting
- not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law

To register, resident electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity. *Please note: a dual driver's license/medical services card does **NOT** count as two pieces of ID.

To register, non-resident property electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from the other property owners. *Please note: a dual driver's license/medical services card does **NOT** count as two pieces of ID.
