 - 1. École Secondaire Ballenas Secondary School:
 - Gr. 8 smooth transition with new system;
 - New computer cart is working well;
 - New teacher joined staff for FI Grade 8 Science and Math
 - 2. École Oceanside Elementary School:
 - 370 Immersion students currently in the school and most classes are full;
 - Several new FI teachers in two Grades ½ classes, in Grade 3/4 class and a return from maternity leave in Grades 4/5 class;
 - Teachers in music, PHE and Makerspace are committed to teaching in French and accessing support through Summer courses as needed;
 - Intermediate classes are all involved in the student vote and will be hosting a candidates meeting at our school;
 - Angela shared how English/French peer buddies and mixing has been positive and reciprocal;
 - Upcoming Remembrance Day assembly on November 7th will be a bilingual event as per usual.
