Public Meetings of the Board of Education

Regular Public Meetings of the Board of Education of the Qualicum School District are held on the fourth Tuesday of each month during the school year, beginning in August.

Two exceptions are the December Board Meeting; which will be held on Tuesday, December 10th, and the March Board Meeting, which will be held on Tuesday, March 11th. There is no meeting held in July.

These meetings are business meetings of the Board which are held in public. The meetings begin at 6:00 p.m. and will be held virtually via Microsoft Teams until further notice. These meetings are recorded and posted on YouTube (Link can be found on the district website).

Committee of the Whole Meetings (COW) normally occur on the 3rd Monday or Tuesday of each month of the school year with none scheduled in July, August, December and March. Check the district calendar for dates and times. These meetings will be held virtually via Microsoft Teams until further notice. These meetings are currently not being recorded.
