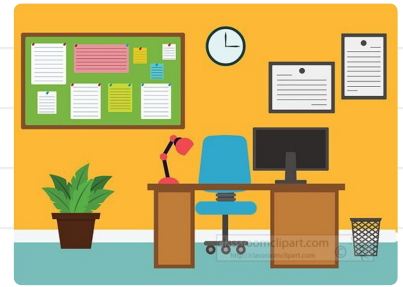

AES Parking Lot – Draft Plan

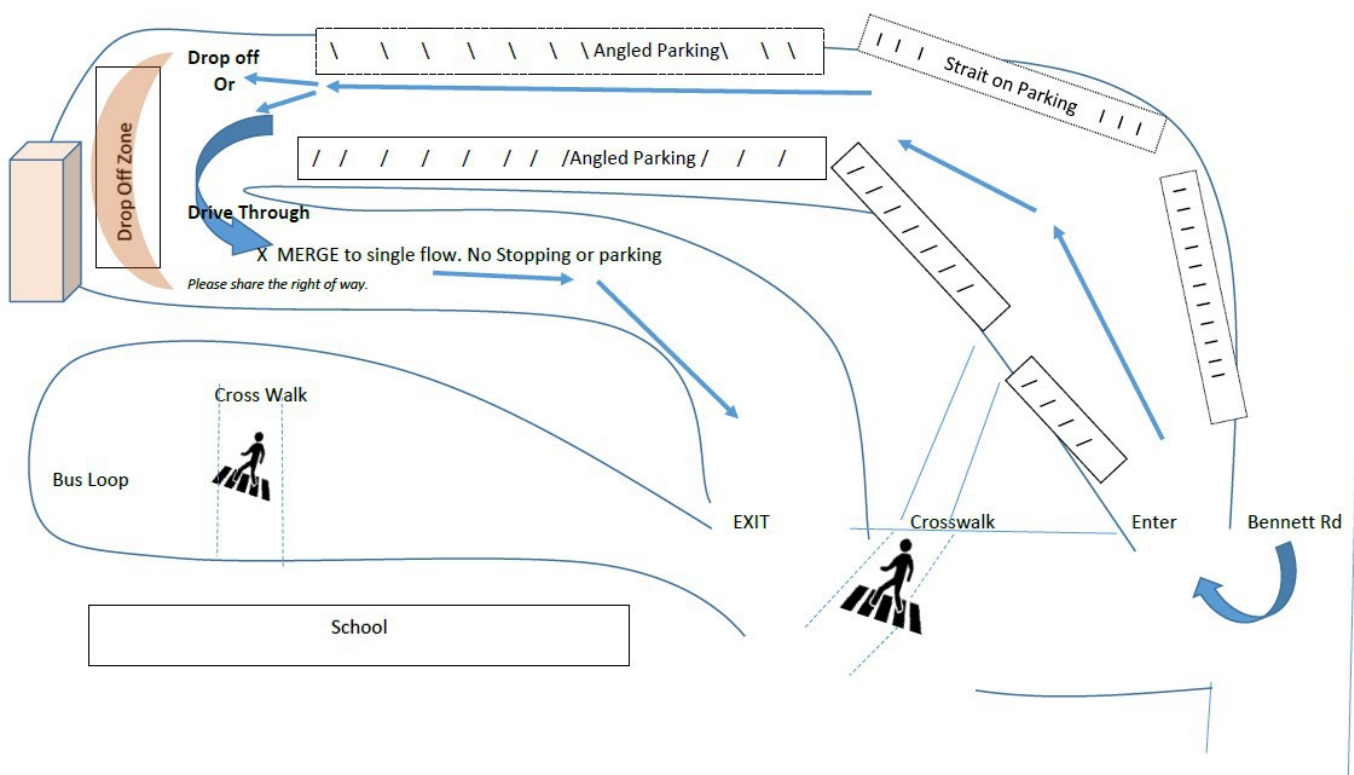
