School Supplies

This coming school year we are again going to do a one-time school supply fee of \$45 for all students in grades 1-7. This has worked very well in the past.

In order to help families and support the students with their learning, we felt this new system would be the best approach due to the increasing cost of living. This will cover all supplies for the year with the exception of indoor shoes. Our hope is that this will make things easier for families getting ready to go back to school in the fall and teachers will get the supplies they need for their individual classroom. What one teacher may need another may not require. This will also provide consistency for the students as everyone will have the same supplies.

We will be opening up School Cash Online for payment as of June 01st (a link will be on the Bowser Elementary School Website) with an end date of September 30th. Families can pay the fee online when they are able, or pay one student at a time, whichever works best for you.
