


- Code of Conduct working group has had 3 meetings and is hoping to have a draft for the next meeting. Code will be for all schools with flexibility for each school to customize for their schools.

As mentioned during our most recent public Board meeting, it is time to start organizing our Strategic Planning Large Group Conversations in earnest. I am (Peter Jory) asking you as a key stakeholder contact to help us put together this group for these upcoming conversations. We are looking for:

- 2. Six members of the senior leadership team
- 3. Six members of the local PVP
- 4. Six parents
- 5. Six members of CUPE 3570
- 6. Twelve members of MATA
- 7. Five members of the Board of Education
- The Dates of Sessions are:
  - Wednesday, February 22 from 12:30-3:30 at Qualicum Commons
  - Thursday, March 9 from 12:30-3:30 at Qualicum Commons
  - o Monday, March 13, from 12:30-3:30 at Qualicum Commons
- Parent/Guardian Reps must be there for the whole session (ie: you are not able leave early for pick up or other commitments)
- It must be the same 6 Parent/Guardian Reps for all 3 days
- Ideally, having 6 Parent/Guardian Reps from a variety of schools is best (Elementary and High School)
- Parents/Guardians can not be employees of SD69 (as they would then be wearing "2 hats" and employees are already included as another stakeholder in the meeting)

The work at these sessions will include an overview of Strategic Planning, the FESL framework that guides us, work completed so far, and then a deeper dive into the survey data and emerging themes with the intention of selecting goal areas, and then the development and wordsmithing of the goals themselves. This will be followed by conversations and table work to identify observable outcomes within each goal area, and the actions required by students, staff, and leadership to make these happen at the highest level.
