Student Learning Support Funds

Student Learning Support Funds the amount of \$600 per year/per student is available for full time K-12 students that enroll in September. (No funding for adult students)

CEAP is required to pay a third-party resource or service provider **directly**, with the exception of reimbursing internet expenses - \$600 per family.

Please Note: Cross Enrolled students are not eligible for Learning Support Funding.

General use for Learning Support Funds

Funds are used in assisting students with enrolled courses such as Fine Arts, Physical Education, and Applied Skills. Funds can be used for supporting lessons in music, dance, horse-back riding, judo, art classes to name a few. Funds are not intended to subsidize equipment such as saddles, telescopes, sports equipment. Further to note that basic consumables such as paper, writing tools, binders ect. are considered to be personal expenses paid for by students or parents and may not be charged against the resource allocation.

Full time students that begins CEAP in September and enrolled in the full year receive \$600 in funding. Allocation of release of funds is on October 1st - \$300 and January - \$300.

Deadline to use funding is May 1st.

To receive funding of \$600.:

- Usually students enroll and complete 6 courses per year
- Completing course work schedule

Partial Funding:

Student that enroll in CEAP after October 1st receive partial funding of \$300.

In the 2024/2025 school year, you may get reimbursed for your internet charges. Simply send your internet bills from September onward to ceap@sd69.bc.ca asking to use your child's **Student Learning Support** funds. A **maximum of \$600 per family** will be allowed to be reimbursed for internet charges.
