GRADUATION PROGRAM 10-12 at CEAP (KSS location)

TIDES GRADUATION PROGRAM 10-12 is an extension of our very popular TIDES 8-9 PROGRAM. This program is for learners who want their education to be based on a blended learning model. For those students who like to dive deeper into their learning both independently and collaboratively. Concepts and skills will be integrated into crosscurricular learning experiences, with all core subjects completed over the 10-month school session. Students in this program are independent learners who must attend in our classroom at Kwalikum Secondary School, on 3 designated ½ days per week, and complete 2 days of independent I-learning. Provisions can be made for students to attend school on I-learning days, in our TIDES Classrooms, to complete their work. During this independent work time students can receive support from CEAP/TIDES staff members if needed.

AT TIDES...

- TIDES provides a package of courses at each grade level, offered in a linear (all year) manner, using a cross-curricular approach to connect learning in different subjects.
- Students participate in two formal inquiry projects, which incorporate all TIDES core subjects with an effort to integrate students interests and passions.
- Students use technology on a daily basis, to support learning and connect them to information and the world around them.
- Students have access to outdoor space used for a variety of alternative learning experiences, including participating in sustainability & agricultural practices.
- Students may attend our TIDES classroom on I-learning days, to work independently. Attendance may become mandatory on I-learning days should the student require more support to be successful.
- Electives and exploratory courses are co-planned by TIDES staff and parents, with support from community partners or from Kwalikum Secondary. Individual student service provider funding is available to support activities.

What TIDES offers ...

- TIDES 10: will include Math 10 (Workplace or FPC), Science 10, Social Studies 10, and English 10 (Creative Writing & Composition).
- TIDES 11: will include Math 11 (3 choices), English New Media 11, Life Sciences 11 or Earth Sciences 11, and a Grade 12 Socials Studies.
- TIDES 12: will include English Studies 12, Anatomy & Physiology 12, Environmental Science 12, and a Grade 12 Socials Studies.
- Other classes are added by using CEAP TIDES/DL or KSS classes at each grade
