### GRADUATION PROGRAM 10-12 at CEAP (KSS location)

TIDES GRADUATION PROGRAM 10-12 is an extension of our very popular TIDES 8-9 PROGRAM. It is designed for learners who want their education to be based on experiential learning, connected to themes such as outdoor learning, sustainability and adventure learning. Concepts and skills will be integrated into cross-curricular learning experiences, with several core subjects completed over the 10-month school session. Students in this program are independent learners who must attend in our classroom at Kwalikum Secondary School, on 3 designated ½ days per week, and complete 2 days of independent e-learning. Provisions can be made for students to attend school on e-learning days, in our learning support room, to receive support for learning or complete their e-learning. Students are provided with learning resources and access to e-learning applications.

### AT TIDES...

- ✓ TIDES provides a package of courses at each grade level, offered in a linear (all year) manner, using a cross-curricular approach to connect learning in different subjects.
- ✓ Students work within the guidelines of the new draft BC Curriculum, with hands-on applications of core learning.
- ✓ Students use technology on a daily basis, to support learning and connect them to information and the world around them.
- ✓ Students are involved in outdoor pursuits, including Stream-keepers, ecology, habitat restoration, local agriculture, navigation, survival and many more challenging activities.
- ✓ Students may attend our CEAP Learning Center on e-learning days, to work independently.
- ✓ Electives and exploratory courses are co-planned by TIDES staff and parents, with support from community partners or from Kwalikum Secondary. Individual student learning grants are available to support activities.

### What TIDES offers ...

- ✓ TIDES 10: will include Math 10, Science 10, Social Studies 10, and English 10.
- ✓ TIDES 11: will include English 11, Life Sciences (Biology) 11, Earth or Environmental Sciences 11, and 20<sup>th</sup> Century World History 11.
- ✓ TIDES 12: will include English 12, Environmental Science 12, Geology 12, and an Inquiry Based Course of Choice (12).
- ✓ Other classes are added by using CEAP DL or KSS classes at each grade level.
