



Technology Integrated Distributed Experiential Studies

Grade 8/9 Program at CEAP (KSS location)

CEAP TIDES is a program for learners who want their education to be based on experiential learning, connected to themes such as outdoor learning, sustainability and adventure learning. Concepts and skills will be integrated into cross-curricular learning experiences, with all core subjects completed over the 10-month school session. Students in this program are independent learners who must attend in our classroom at Qualicum Secondary School, on 3 designated ½ days per week, and complete 2 days of independent e-learning. Provisions can be made for students to attend school on e-learning days, in our learning support room, to receive support for learning or complete their e-learning. Students are provided with learning resources and access to e-learning applications.

AT TIDES...

- ✓ TIDES provides all aspects of the student's program, with core courses offered in a linear (all year) manner, using a cross-curricular approach to connect learning in different subjects.
- ✓ Students work within the guidelines of the new BC Curriculum, with hands-on applications of core learning.
- ✓ Students use technology on a daily basis, to support learning and connect them to information and the world around them.
- ✓ Students are involved in outdoor pursuits, including Stream-keepers, ecology, habitat restoration, local agriculture, navigation, survival and many more challenging activities.
- ✓ Students may attend our CEAP Learning Center on e-learning days, to work independently.
- ✓ Electives and exploratory courses are co-planned by TIDES staff and parents, with support from community partners. Individual student learning grants are available to support activities.

TWO TIDES OPTIONS...

- ✓ TIDES CORE: will include Math, Science, Social Studies, English, and Career Education. Other classes are added by using CEAP DL or KSS classes
- ✓ TIDES FULL TIME: will include Math, Science, Social Studies, English, and Career Education as well as: French 8 (if in grade 8), Physical and Health Education, Arts Education, and App. Design Skills and Tech General Exploration. (all courses required at each grade level)
