MESSAGE FROM THE ADMINISTRATORS

If a child will be going on a different bus to go to a friend's house, this needs to be planned ahead of time and a note needs to be brought to school stating what the plan is. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.

Please make all after school arrangements before school starts. The office has had an influx of calls and it is very difficult to get these messages to students at times. Thank you in advance for supporting us with this issue.

VISITORS TO EES

When your visit is complete, please return your tag, and sign out on the sign-in sheet (again, during emergencies this is very helpful). 
