A great deal of work has been done to ensure we are meeting the provincial health and safety guidelines put in place for the students whose parents have chosen to allow their children to attend school on a limited basis. Any student wishing to return to school in June MUST be PRE-ARRANGED. This includes riding the school bus. There are guidelines around which day(s) your child can attend and how many students are permitted to be in each class at any given time. Please contact the school office if you have not confirmed your child's attendance.

Please know that if your child will be continuing with their at home learning program during the month of June, your classroom teacher will continue to provide support remotely and communicate with you regularly. Your child's work will be the same as those students who are at school. You can still work on as much as you and your family feel comfortable with. Report Cards will be emailed to you at the end of June. We have set the dates of June 15th and June 16th for you to schedule a time to pick up your child's belongings if you haven't already.
