Good evening Errington Families,

First of all, we hope that you and your families are feeling well and staying safe at home. We have missed you all, and there is nothing we'd rather do on Monday than have you all back in the building. Unfortunately, we will have to wait for that and look to doing things differently for the next while. As you most likely will have heard, our province has suspended "face to face" instruction and has tasked us with providing meaningful learning opportunities that students can engage in from home. Our goal is to continue to be an important and positive part of your family's life.

We have been working with the entire district leadership team for the past week, and will be working with our teachers next week to begin to address the following Ministry of Education priorities:

- 1. Maintain a healthy and safe environment for all students, families and employees
- 2. Provide the services needed to support children of our essential service workers in the community
- 3. Support vulnerable students who may need special assistance
- 4. Provide continuity of educational opportunities for all students

BIG PICTURE FOR NEXT WEEK

- This week will be used for planning purposes.
- Only I and/or Ms. Fuhrmann (VP) will be working in the building next week. With that, we are restricted to certain hours in the building and will also be working from home.
- Teachers will be contacting families by phone or email later this week. We want to establish connection with students and families as we move forward with our planning around continuity of learning.
- We recognize that some students may need to retrieve essential items left at the school. We will eventually establish an appointment schedule for students/parents to enter the school if necessary. This will likely occur later in the week. Until we have this process determined, we ask that students/parents not try to access the building. BEYOND NEXT WEEK

Teachers will work towards connecting with students in their respective classes and providing suggestions for learning activities. The focus will likely be on age appropriate literacy, numeracy and core competency development. This will look different; we will find a way to support our learners, but teachers need some time to plan how to best support our students in our current context. Ideas and suggested activities may involve subject area explorations and inquiry, but these activities **will not** be a continuation of grade specific curriculum or assessment.
