HOW TO ORDER:

✓ If you do NOT currently have a MunchaLunch account:

1. Go to: <https://munchalunch.com/schools/sd69dpac/>
2. Click "**Register Here**", and then click "**Yes**" (to confirm your school is School District 69 DPAC)
3. Complete the *New Account Registration* and click "**Create My Account**", then click "**Save and Continue**"
4. Complete the *My Children* page (Families: Add one child's name & their school ~or~ SD69 Staff: Add your name & staff as your division), click "**Save**"
5. Click "**2023 District Swag**" on the top black bar...then start shopping! Click "**Verify My Order**" when you are done filling your basket
6. Click "**Submit my Order**" on The *Verify Your Order* page. Click "**Done**" (Or create another order), and complete your order by paying

✓ If you DO have a MunchaLunch account:

1. Go to: <https://munchalunch.com/addaccount>
2. Click "**Start**"
3. Complete 'Step 1' (by adding the email and MunchaLunch password you use) and click "**Verify**", (your current school will be shown), click "**Select my 2nd School**"
4. Complete 'Step 2' by choosing 'Parksville' from the drop down list
5. Complete 'Step 3' by choosing 'School District 69 DPAC' from the drop down list
6. Complete the process by clicking "**Yes, ADD this School**"
7. Your next screen will say ..Successfully Added School... and show School District 69 & your school. Click "**Go to Login Page**" (and log in using your email and MunchaLunch password) to start your DPAC SWAG order! (refer to detailed instructions above, as necessary)

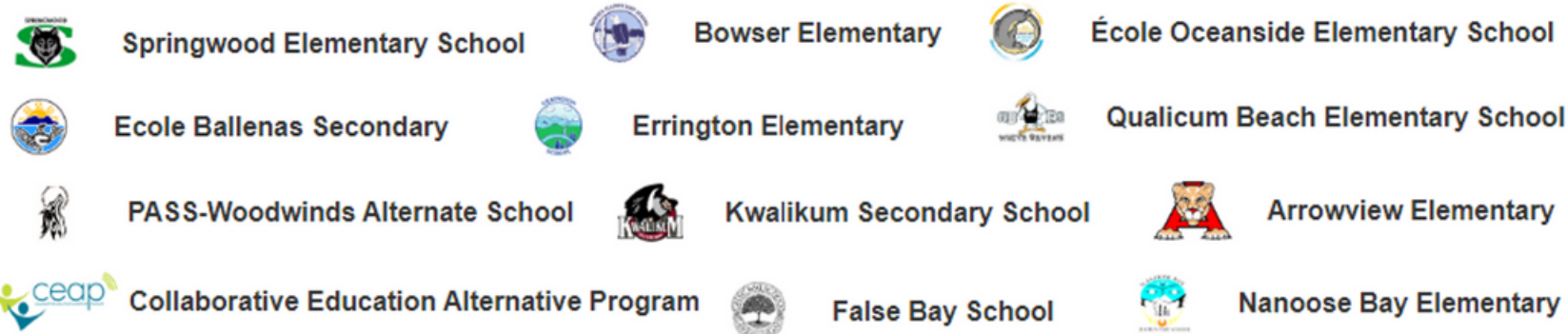

- ▶ Each PAC varies from school to school depending on:
 - Volunteers & Availability
 - PAC Constitution
- ▶ Most PACs have:
 - Executive Members (Chair/President, Vice Chair/President, Treasurer, Secretary, Members at Large)
 - PAC Constitution
 - Monthly Meetings
 - Meetings with School Administrators
 - Fundraisers & School PAC Activities

Each school PAC is then part of SD69 DPAC – School District 69 District Parent Advisory Council

What is DPAC?

District Parent Advisory Council:

- ▶ Provides support for PACs in their role as advisors to their school
 - Helps PACs network: Typically, if one school has a question/concern/need, other schools will have the same
 - DPAC is the umbrella voice for all the individual PACs in our district
 - DPAC adheres to guidelines set out by BCCPAC – BC Confederation of Parent Advisory Councils
- ▶ Provides & Organizes:
 - PAC Constitution and PAC Role workshops
 - Parent training opportunities (For example: Food Safe, Internet Safety, Anxiety, Vaping, First Aid)
- ▶ SD69 DPAC has monthly meetings attended by or a combination of:
 - Parents/Guardians and DPAC Executives from individual SD69 School PACs
 - SD69 Trustees / Board Members / Senior Staff
 - MATA – Mount Arrowsmith Teacher Association Rep
 - CUPE Local 3570 – Canadian Union of Public Employees Rep

SD69 DPAC Executives are all VOLUNTEERS!

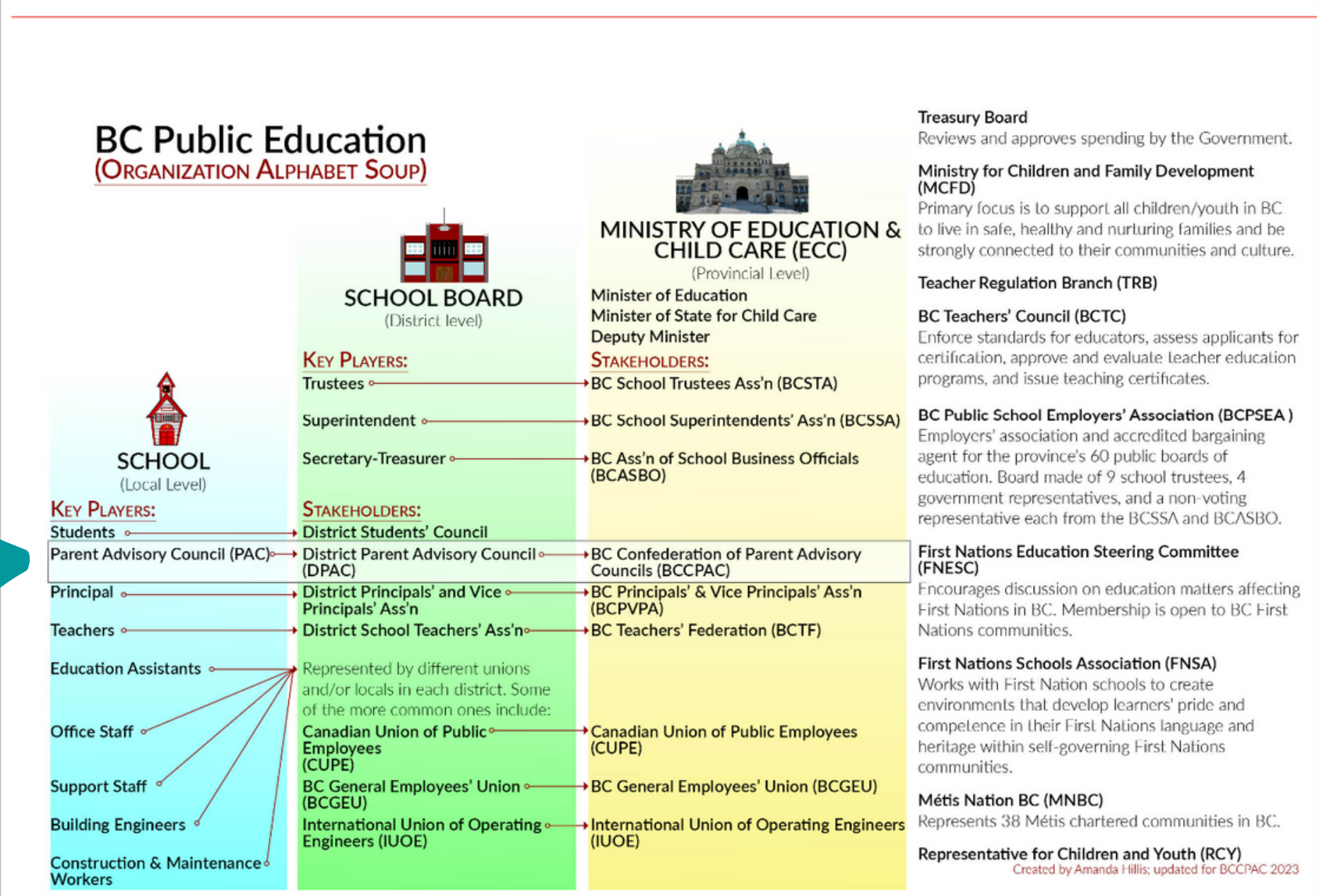
