# SCHOOL BUS REGISTRATION FOR THE 2025/26 SCHOOL YEAR IS NOW OPEN!

Go to the Qualicum School District Transportation <u>website</u> to access the online application form. Get your application in **before the end of this school year** for the best opportunity to secure a spot for you child and to **avoid extra fees**.

#### **Bussing Fee Summary Table**

\*Parents and caregivers who believe these fees will cause financial hardship in their household are encouraged to speak to their school principal about fee relief. Options may include partial or even full fee waivers, depending on need, which will then be communicated by the principal to the Transportation Department.

#### **REGISTRATION PROCESSING TIMELINES**

April – June 30 only Eligible bus pass applications will be processed, on a first come/first served basis.

- If a bus reaches capacity, an *Eligible Rider wait lis*t will be created. You will be notified if you are put on a wait list.
- Courtesy rider applications received during this time will not be processed until after July 1.
  - Once processed and accepted, individual bus route information is shared with families through the My Ride K-12 website and App. See sign-up instructions here: My Ride K12 Set Up FAQ

July 1- onwards Courtesy, as well as late Eligible bus pass applications will be processed on a first come/first served basis as space is available on the bus route(s) requested.

- Courtesy riders that are offered a space on the bus will be notified and asked to pay the necessary fees. When payment is received the application will be finalized. If payment is not made within 5 business days of being offered the space, the application will be re-dated and put back into the queue.
- If a bus reaches capacity, a wait list will be created. You will be notified if you are put on a wait list.
- Exact bus route information will be distributed to families before the first day of school through My Ride K-12 website and App.

Applications received after Sept 1 will be considered on a wait list and only accepted on a first come first served basis as space on busses allow.

#### SOME IMPORTANT YEAR END REMINDERS FOR YOU:

- We have a Transportation lost and found at our shop at 1365 Springhill Road in Parksville. If your child is missing anything that might have been left on the bus, feel free to stop in to check for it. We donate all unclaimed items to SOS in July.
- Please ask your child to hold onto their bus pass card, we reuse them year over year, so they will need them in September.
- Please be aware that after June ends, bus registration fees increase. So if you haven't already, please register for bussing through the online form on the Transportation page of our website.
- Lastly, and most importantly, all route information for next school year will be released to parents
  using the MyRide K-12 website and App in late August. Next years bus routes will not be the same as
  they are this year. All families must create a profile on the website or App to obtain route
  information for next year. This service also lets you see the bus pass scan history of your child and the
  location of the bus when its coming to your stop. Please make sure to sign up by following the attached


Thank you for continuing to entrust transporting your children to us. It has been a privilege to watch them grow this past year and see some of them complete their journey with us through graduation.

# SUGGESTED/RECOMMENDED SUPPLY LIST

# Essentials – these are the items that all students will need for most courses:

- □ 3 Ring Binder(s) with enough space to keep 4 courses of material
- Dividers to keep binder organized
- □ Loose-leaf paper (wide ruled 200 sheets)
- Pens and pencils
- □ Non-marking runners/proper footwear & appropriate gym strip (PE students)

# Recommended – these will be helpful in many classes:

- □ Erasers and highlighters
- □ Metric ruler (clear plastic preferred)
- □ Set pencil crayons or felt pens
- □ Calculator: scientific calculator (a simple calculator with sin, cos, and tan on it worth about \$10).
- □ Water bottle (with student's name on it)

#### Personal Computers: At KSS, we recommend and welcome

laptops/chromebooks. WiFi is available throughout the school. Chromebooks are used in many classrooms and we have a number available to students and classrooms. They are a reasonable device (\$200+/-), need no software, and the School District has the protected domain: Google Apps for Education (G-Suite) for each student.

This is a general list and not meant to cover all possible required supplies. Individual teachers, especially elective classes, may request additional items.
