ADMINISTRATION REPORT – Lori M. and Lesley R.

- December 19th Power outage followed by an incident in one of the boys' bathrooms where a large round toilet paper dispenser was lit on fire. Fire was a significant one resulting in a lot of smoke and the attendance of the fire department. Students were evaculated to the field (which was covered in snow) and the gym (which did not have lights due to the power outage). As well, the PA system was not working due to power outage. Students were released from school early and the washroom was closed, repainted and re-opened on January 9th. The combination of the power outage and the fire was challenging and was a good opportunity to test out the school's emergency procedures. A debriefing will take place to see where improvements can be made.
- First semester is winding down. Second semester begins January 29th. Grade 8 students will continue with their linear classes and begin new electives. Grades 9-12 will start a new semester.
- January 22nd to 24th regular classes in session.
- January 25th and 26th:
 - Grade 8 students <u>regular classes in the morning</u>. If students are totally caught up, flex time in the afternoon. Buses will be running at the regular time.
 - Grades 9-12 regular classes NOT in session.
 - All Grade 11 students in the Grad program will be writing provincial assessments on the morning of January 25th (English 12) and the afternoon of 26th (Communications 12) (www.curriculum.gov.bc.ca/provincial-assessment/graduation).
- Report cards will be issued on February 9th or 10th.

- Formal Grad portraits scheduled with Concept Photography (www.conceptphoto.ca) for January 31st and February 1st in the MPR. Information has been sent home with Grade 12 students and is available on the school website (www.sd69.bc.ca/school/KSS/Documents/KSS%20Grad%20Photo%20Information.pdf). Follow-up session scheduled for February 15th for retakes and yearbook only photos.
- Concept Photography is being considered for future years for school photos (instead of LifeTouch).
