Grade 10-12 Cohort at KSS

The Graduation Cohort is an extension of the Jr. TIDES program. This program is for learners who want their education to be based on a blended learning model, using inquiry based approaches. Concepts and skills will be integrated into cross-curricular learning experiences, with all core subjects completed in the 10 month school session.

AT TIDES

- TIDES provides a package of courses at each grade level, primarily offered in a semester manner, using a cross-curricular approach to connect learning to different subjects
- TIDES 10: will include Math 10 (Found Pre-Cal), Science 10, Social Studies 10, English First Peoples 10, CLE 10 and Physical and Health Education 10
- TIDES 11: may include Math 11 (Foundations 11), English New Media 11, Life Sciences or Earth Sciences 11, a Grade 12 Social Studies, CLC 12 A and Active Living 11
- TIDES 12: may include English Studies 12, Anatomy & Physiology 12, Grade 12 Social Studies, CLC 12 B (Capstone Project) and Active Living 12
- To fulfill graduation requirements or university entrance requirements, other classes may be added through KSS timetabled classes or cross-enrollment with CEAP Online classes at each grade level

FLEXIBLE LEARNING

Students will attend 5 days per week and will be students of Kwalikum Secondary School. Most classes will be completed within the TIDES cohort; however, each student will have an individual learning plan that may include elective classes chosen from within the KSS timetable, distributed learning classes or other experiential learning opportunities from outside the school.
