Languages Japanese 10	MJA--10	Grade 10 Credits 4
A continuation of Japanese language development building on knowledge and skills developed in Japanese 9.		
Languages French 11	MFR--11	Grade 11 Credits 4
French 11 builds on the themes, the vocabulary and the grammar established in French 10). The aim of the course is to give students exposure to the French language in its four forms: listening, speaking, writing and reading. The use of real-life documents assists the students in acquiring a more lifelike knowledge of French.		
Languages Japanese 11	MJA--11	Grade 11 Credits 4
This course is a continuation of Japanese 10. Speaking, listening, reading and writing skills are emphasized. Students will become more familiar with variations in vocabulary, expression and sentence structure. The use of Kanji is expanded and Japanese culture is discussed where time permits. Japanese 11 meets the language credit requirements for post-secondary institutions in BC.		
Languages French 12	MFR--12	Grade 12 Credits 4
This course is designed for students who wish to gain a greater knowledge and appreciation of the French language. This course builds upon skills and vocabulary in French 11 and encourages students to listen to and to speak French. Some opportunity to study the works of French-language authors will be offered.		
Languages Japanese 12	MJA--12	Grade 12 Credits 4
A continuation of Japanese language development building on knowledge and skills developed in Japanese 11.
