

Local Scholarships

- Application available in February and close in March will have info sessions ahead of time during seminar
- Wide range of awards available: academics, financial need, community service, Indigenous culture, athletics, fine arts, languages, trades, applied skills
- Not all based on academics and not all need to be used that same year.

Transcripts/Credits

- · Initial pass of the non-grad list has been done we will be connecting with students who are missing grad requirements
- November DVR's will be sent out to students to check their own credits and make sure everything looks good ahead of Semester 2
- Transcripts: most post-secondary institutions require students to send marks directly from the Ministry via Student Transcript Service (they will need to set up an account to do this). PSI's typically start pulling marks in the new year/spring.
- External Credits: students who have certificates for things like Royal Conservatory, Cadets, Lifeguarding, Competitive athletics, etc, bring your documentation to counselling to get credits added to your transcript if applicable.
- Be aware of post-secondary dates/deadlines for online courses
