Before School Care

This program offers before-school care every school day from 7:30am until the morning bell for students in Kindergarten to Grade 5 at a cost of \$100 per month. Monthly payments are collected through School Cash Online and applications for subsidy through the Ministry of Children and Family Development are available upon request.

The before-school program is run by a qualified Qualicum School District staff member. Having a program on site helps make the transition from before school to school a positive and familiar experience. Before-school activities include games, crafts, and other activities. The program is held in Room 16, just to the right of the main entrance which makes for a very easy drop-off. When the bell rings, students in the before-school program simply walk to their classroom from the before-school care. This program is convenient for children and families and provides a safe, enriching experience in a familiar place.

Dogs at School
