ABSENCE REPORTING: We are using the Safe Arrival and School Messenger tools to report absences, and connect with families about unexcused absences. MORNING ROUTINES: Arriving on time supports participation in planned re-connect activities and instructions, time to connect with classmates, and prepare for a successful day. Students are marked late if they arrive after the 8:09 bell. Please support your child to be as punctual as possible. Students must check into the office if they arrive late. If leaving early please check out at the office.
