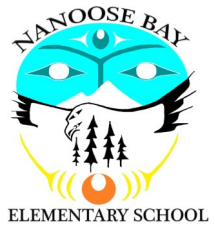

Indigenous Culture Group

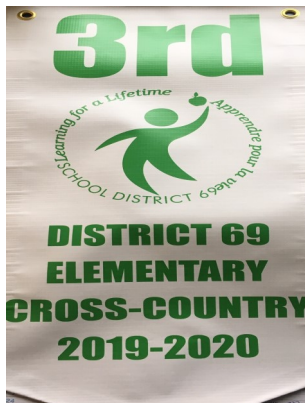
Linda Rabideau offers an Indigenous Culture group every Friday at lunch recess. Any students from grade 1-7 at NBES can sign up.
