A note from Island Health: Kindergarten Immunizations

To make routine immunization more accessible to children, Island Health is offering school-based immunization clinics for students in kindergarten who are due for routine immunizations (excluding COVID-19 & influenza).

Only children who are due for routine immunization(s) will receive a letter through the school. If your child receives a letter, please complete the online digital consent. Students will only be offered immunizations in a school-based clinic with the consent of a parent/guardian.

If you would like to attend an appointment with your child, contact your local health unit to book an appointment. Please ensure your child can recite their full name and date of birth, as the public health nurse will need to confirm this information with your child prior to providing immunizations.
