CEAP TIDES is a program for learners who want their education to be based on experiential learning, connected to themes such as outdoor learning, sustainability and adventure learning. Concepts and skills will be integrated into cross-curricular learning experiences, with all core subjects completed over the 10-month school session. Students in this program are independent learners who must attend in our classroom at Kwalikum Secondary School, on 3 designated ½ days per week, and complete 2 days of independent e-learning. Provisions can be made for students to attend school on e-learning days, in our learning support room, to receive support for learning or to complete their e-learning. Students are provided with learning resources and access to e-learning applications.

This exciting approach to education has been designed to align with the Ministry of Education's new curriculum for grades 8-12. It is the future of education.
