PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Hello QBES Parents & Guardians,

'Uy skweyul.

As we go into a well-deserved long weekend that marks the 'end of the beginning' of the school year, staff are noticing that classes are now well settled into the routines. Teachers have been telling us how pleased they are with their students' kind and curious natures. Teachers are looking forward to parent conferences which are coming up October 20-22. (See the link attached later in this newsletter to book your appointments.) I encourage you to take advantage of the opportunity to meet with your child's teacher to get a sense of the class routines and the teacher's early observations - as well as to share your deep knowledge of your child.

Our grade 5 to 7 students are now excitedly engaged in their rotation of exploratory classes. These classes are offered in 6 week blocks for two hours and cover much of students' learning in Fine Arts and ADST (Applied Design Skills and Technologies). Multi-age groupings of students are currently learning Performance Arts, Cooking, Photography, Digital Literacy, Shop, Visual Art, and Design Challenges. The kids and teachers alike have been looking forward to Wednesday afternoons!

Staff enjoyed an outstanding day of learning on September 29 sponsored by the Qualicum School District's Indigenous Education department. Our staff has committed to getting language and culture learning in front of students in new ways. You might have heard from your kids about their new 'Kookum' (grandmother) who is really named Brenda. She is our Indigenous Education Advocate here at the school and has already drummed and sung the students the Eagle Song at two assemblies and has led some classroom circle meetings. If your family has Indigenous ancestry, reach out to Kookum to introduce yourself!

Finally, we are in need of wrapping up school supplies payments in the coming days. If you have not yet paid your \$50 school supply fee, please do so as soon as you can or call the school office to arrange a payment plan. We depend on recovering these fees as the supplies for your child were preordered. Unpaid fees put the school in a deficit situation.

GR.6 IMMUNIZATIONS

Grade 6 Immunizations

In B.C the Human Papilloma (HPV) vaccine is recommended for all grade 6 students as part of their routine immunization schedule. Grade 6 students may be eligible for additional vaccines if they are not up to date. A letter with instructions on providing consent for immunizations has now been sent home to students via email. Please follow the instructions and provide consent or refusal to immunizations using the new digital consent platform.

Immunizations will be provided at the school for grade 6 students who have consent, on Nov 5, 2025.

School Appointments – Parent Instructions


1. Go to our school appointments web site for your school.

QBES Appointments Link

- Register for an account by clicking the "REGISTER" menu tab and filling in the on-line form. Choose a user id and password for yourself and then click the "Register Now" button.
- Add your children into the system by clicking the "Add a Student" button. Click the "Insert New" button to add more children.
- 4. Click the "date" icon beside each child's name to schedule appointments. Select the staff you wish to book appointments with and the "View Calendars" button. Use the "Ctrl" or "Command" key to select multiple staff to view at the same time.



5. Click on available time slots to book your appointments to make your bookings.
