Please note, SES PAC does not have a Facebook account, and we do not monitor Facebook, Twitter or Instagram accounts.

#### **Hot Lunch**

PAC Executives have been in contact with the School Administration and MunchaLunch Administrators and we have decided to CANCEL all Hot Lunch Orders for the 2019\20 school year and CREDIT all the SES accounts. As MunchaLunch does not keep Credit Card numbers on file, we cannot refund through MunchaLunch.

Your options for the Hot Lunch refund are as follows:

- OPTION 1 "Roll Over" the Credit to the 2020\21 School Year
  - You do not need to contact PAC. This is the *default option* that will be applied to all accounts, unless SES PAC is otherwise contacted with another option.
  - If you have a grade 7 student leaving SES, but other children still at SES, the "grade 7's credit" will automatically be applied to a sibling at SES.
  - $_{\odot}\mbox{This}$  option supports Social Distancing guidelines.

• OPTION 2 - "Donate" the Credit to a student, to be used in the 2020\21 School Year

- $_{\odot}$  Contact PAC, as indicated below, and let them know you have chosen this option.
- This will be an anonymous donation. PAC Executive will work with School Administration to ensure your donation goes to a student who, would not otherwise, be able to participate in Hot Lunch.
- If you have a grade 7 student leaving SES, and no other students at SES, you may still choose to donate your "grade 7's credit"
- $_{\odot}$  This option supports Social Distancing guidelines.
- OPTION 3 "Cheque Refund" will result in a paper Cheque being mailed to you by the end of April
  - $\circ$  Contact PAC, as indicated below, and let them know you have chosen this option.
  - If you have a grade 7 student leaving SES, and no other students at SES and you wish to not donate the money, you would choose this option.
  - This option does not support Social Distancing guidelines and will be performed as long as PAC Executives and School Administration can carry out all tasks safely. (All SES PAC Cheques require 2 Executive Member signatures. PAC will then work with the School to obtain envelopes, stamps and mailing addresses to complete the mail out process).

What actions are required, by you, by Friday, April 10<sup>th</sup> at 3pm?:

- 1. Log into MunchaLunch: <u>https://munchalunch.com/</u> and see what your credit amount is.
- 2. Decide which Option (Option 1, 2 or 3 as detailed above) you would like.
  - If you choose Option 1: No further action is required by you.
  - If you choose Option 2 or 3: Please email <u>springwoodpac@gmail.com</u> and advise us of the option you chose.
