

Criminal Record Checks for the School

Do I really need to get one?

- Yes If you want to read in the class, volunteer on craft days, walk to the beach with the classes or attend field trips (include the big trips like Hornby and Playland)
- The SES administration keeps a list of everyone who has a Criminal Record Check on file, as well as each teacher has a list for their class
- Each school in SD69 requires their own Criminal Record Check as well, so if you have one at Ballenas (for example) you will also need one at SES

Can I wait until my kids actually goes on a field trip to get one?

- You could...but you might kick yourself and regret waiting as it takes the RCMP 2 weeks to process the forms
- The Criminal Record lasts for 5 years so why not proactively get one now and then you are covered for almost all of your elementary years

Is it a pain to get the form and submit it?

- No (and trust me...I dislike forms) Stop in at the SES office and they have a stapled group of papers right there. Pick it up, take it home and fill it out and then drive over to the RCMP on Pym. They get hundreds of volunteers dropping them off so they know the drill and are efficient. In less than 5 minutes, they check over your form and tell you to come back in 2 weeks.
- o 2 weeks later you pop back into the RCMP and pick up the form then drop it off at SES!
