That is the question of the day... Answer: "Maybe" (see – that's a good parent type answer!)


In short, as SD69 adheres to COVID protocols, PAC's need to think about if/how a Hot Lunch would work. **Here's our challenges:** 

- Large groups of volunteers can't be in the school (Typically hot lunch requires 5-10 volunteers on average setting up a command center in the Foods room for around 5 hours while we sort and pack hot lunches then deliver to 21 classes)
- Staggered lunch hours for cohorts This presents challenges if we were, for example, going to get Pizza dropped off.
- Uncertainty: In general, PAC could plan hot lunches, place vendor orders, shop for inventory...but if our COVID phases were to change and things get shut down in the City....well....PAC might then just curl up in the corner with their 100 pizzas and cry.

#### **BUT WAIT!....THERE'S MORE:**

PAC is thinking of a way we could offer something like "Bring a toonie and get a juice box, packaged Rice Krispie square or treat" .... Or something like that, where we could set up a volunteer table outside and teachers can bring their classes and money up to participate during a lunch or recess.

Our SES PAC is known for being very casual, fun and SUPPORTIVE! We want you to be able to come to a meeting for a bit, ask some questions, hear some school updates and then sign off in time to catch some Netflix....I mean put the kids to bed.
- Why is this October meeting Important? The PAC Budget Meeting is the meeting where the school presents to us their "wish list" of items for the year and we determine and forecast how much \$\$ we think, as a PAC, we can raise this year and how much we can support the school. The last few years (with help from all the SES Families & Community members) we have been able to give the school over \$20,000 each year. Typically the money goes to things like field trips, books for the library, indoor outdoor sport equipment, new supplies for the Foods Room and fun events like the Winter Wonderland skate This year: We are focusing on items and events that can be used to enhance our COVID learning time. Outdoor sports equipment or games that cohorts can utilize have been thrown around as a good idea.
