

What is a PAC?

Officially...Parent Advisory Council is:

- PAC is the officially recognized collective voice of parents of their school
 - Each school has their own PAC
- PACs are forums, within each school community, to discuss matters affecting your school and the education of your children
- PACs strive to represent the diversity within their communities and contribute to the benefit of all students by:
 - Providing opportunities to educate and inform parents about the school
 - Involving parents in volunteer activities
 - Openly discussing parents' concerns and aspirations for their schools

Parents' voices are a tremendous value to their school They offer a wealth of ideas and support in the challenges that face all public schools.

SES PAC prides themselves on being inclusive, transparent & mostly super FUN! ...sometimes silly...maybe mostly silly...




Without PAC

What is DPAC?

District **P**arent **A**dvisory **C**ouncil:

- Provides support for PACs in their role as advisors to their school
 - Helps PACs network: Typically if one school has a question/concern/need, others schools will have the same
 - DPAC is the umbrella voice for all the individual PACs in our district
 - DPAC adheres to guidelines set out by BCCPAC BC Confederation of Parent Advisory Councils
- Provides & Organizes:
 - PAC Constitution and PAC Role workshops
 - Parent training opportunities (For example: Food Safe, Internet Safety, Anxiety, Vaping, First Aid)
- SD69 DPAC has monthly meetings attended by or a combination of:
 - DPAC Reps & Chairs from individual SD69 School PACs
 - SD69 Trustees / Board Members / Senior Staff
 - MATA Mount Arrowsmith Teacher Association Rep

- Elections are held near the end of the school year, but some positions are not filled, or left open, until the beginning of the next school year

- All parents/guardians with students registered in SES are automatically a PAC Voting Member ("Member at Large")
