#### IN PERSON:

- 1. Go to our school appointments web site by clicking School Appointments
- 2. Register for an account by clicking the "**REGISTER**" menu tab and filling in the on-line form. Choose a user id and password for yourself and then click the "Register Now" button.
- 3. Add your children into the system by clicking the "Add a Student" button. Click "Insert New" button to add more children.
- 4. Click the "date" icon beside each child's name to schedule appointments. Select the staff you wish to book appointments with and the "View Calendars" button. Use the "Ctrl" or "Command" key to select multiple staff to view at the same time.
- 5. Click on available time slots to book your appointments and then click the "Book Appointments" button to save your bookings

#### Happy Halloween

As you know, Halloween is on Thursday, October 31st. We are planning some safe, fun activities for students to do at school on that day. We have decided to once again allow students to wear costumes if they wish! Students may wear a costume on Thursday, October 31st. If your child does not want to wear a costume, we Happy

encourage students to wear black and/or orange. We do have some costume guidelines that must be followed to ensure everyone has a safe and fun day:

- Masks are NOT to be worn outside on the playground or in the hallways and washrooms.
- Masks can be worn during the parade. Teachers will give direction on the expectations in classrooms.
- No heavy make-up. Leave all costume "weapons" at home (swords, knives, guns, etc.).
- Bring a change of clothes (some students have PE class and may be asked to change if the costume interferes with mobility).
- Please make sure your child avoids costumes portraying extreme violence. After Halloween, we ask you to please limit the amount of candy you let your child take to school. Generally, we

ask students to eat something healthy first before consuming a treat. The costume parade will start at 9:30 am. Parents are welcome to come watch. This should be a great activity for SES students.

Immunization consent packages for grade 6 students have been sent home. Follow the instructions inside the consent package and return the signed consent form to the school as soon as possible. Students in grade 6 will be offered routine immunizations in school-based clinics with the consent of a parent/guardian/representative.

Immunizations will be provided at the school for grade 6 students on Tuesday, November 5th, 2024 and Monday May 5th, 2025.

Currently, pertussis is increasing in Canada as part of the expected cyclical peak of the disease (occurring every 2-5 years). Pertussis, or whooping cough, is a very contagious (easy to catch) diseas of the respiratory tract. It is caused by a bacterium (germ) found in the mouth, nose and throat of a person who is infected. In Aug 2024, BC saw 72 cases of pertussis, 16 of which were on Vancouver Island and the majority of the 16 cases were unimmunized or under immunized. Cases of pertussis a expected to increase this fall/school year. The best way to protect your child against pertussis is to get them immunized. In British Columbia, the pertussis vaccine is part of the routine childhood immunization program, and is given at 2 montt 4 months, 6 months, and 18 months old, and again at age 4 to 6 years (before kindergarten). A pertussis vaccine is also given to teens at 14 to 16 years of age (Grade 9). Children who are currently in Grade 6 or 9 will be offered all immunizations they are due for through school-based immunizatio clinics. Information and consent forms will be distributed through the school this fall or early 2025. The ImmunizeBC Vaccination Status Indicator (https://immunizebc.ca/vaccination-status-indicator) can also be used to find out if your child's immunization records are in the Provincial Immunization Registry. If your child was immunized at a public health unit, community health centre, school, or pharmacy, their record should already be in the registry. If your child was immunized at a First Nations community health centre, doctor's office, or outside BC, their record might not be in the registry yet. If the Vaccination Status Indicator shows that your child's vaccination status is <b>complete</b> , you do not need to do anything.
