Happy Halloween

As you know, Halloween is on Tuesday, October 31st. We are planning some safe, fun activities for students to do at school on that day.



We have decided to once again allow students to wear costumes if they wish! Students may wear a costume on Tuesday, October 31st.

If your child does not want to wear a costume, we encourage students to wear black and/or orange.

We do have some costume guidelines that must be followed to ensure everyone has a safe and fun day:

- Masks are NOT to be worn outside on the playground or in the hallways and washrooms.
 Masks can be worn during the parade.
- Teachers will give direction on the expectations in classrooms.
- No heavy make-up.
- Leave all costume "weapons" at home (swords, knives, guns, etc.).
- Bring a change of clothes (some students have PE class and may be asked to change if the costume interferes with mobility).
- Please make sure your child avoids costumes portraying extreme violence.
- After Halloween, we ask you to please limit the amount of candy you let your child take to school.
- Generally, we ask students to eat something healthy first before consuming a treat.

The costume parade will start at 11:00 am in the gym. Parents are welcome to come watch.

This should be a great activity for SES students.

Student Absences - Safe Arrival

Dear School Families,

School District 69 is launching the SafeArrival component of the SchoolMessenger tool. This is a tool that provides multiple ways for parents to report absences when their child will be away and also speeds the process of reaching out to parents when a child is not at school. Please see the attached letter for details.



In the attached letter you will see that parents have three ways of reporting an absence, regardless of which option you choose, you will need to use the contact information that you have provided to the school. Using the app or website will require you to create an account with your email address. Please use the email that the school has on file for you (the one you that is receiving this message). If you choose to use the phone system to report an absence you will be asked to provide the phone number the school has on file for you in order to use the system. This information is what connects you to your child/children in the system.

You can continue to report absences by calling the school at 250-248-2038 but we are strongly encouraging families to use the SchoolMessenger app, website.
