Dear Board of School Trustees,

At this time, I would like to apply for Final approval for a trip to Germany (Berlin and Munich), Czech Republic (Prague), Austria, Liechtenstein and Switzerland (Lucerne) and France (Paris) during Spring Break 2023. I am planning to take a group of 43 students with the support of 6 other teachers and an experienced tour Education First (EF) tour director. Since receiving preliminary approval, we have initiated student lead activities to build awareness of the fortunate position the students are in to be able to travel internationally. The environmental action has resulted in measurable changes in the school community. We have improved recycling efforts by students and influenced meaningful reflection on the level of pollution the student body is making the local community and via international travel.

My experience is that these trips provide incredible and memorable life experiences for our students and they are exceptional educational tools. An educational highlight of this trip will be difference and similarities between cultures of Europe and Canada. Additionally, it will expose the causes and impacts of Genocide, World War 2 and the Cold war. The trip has been be co-curricular in design with Genocide Studies 12 as 95% of travelling students enrolled in Genocide Studies 12. Additionally, 89 % of the travelers have also enrolled in History 12. The students are excited to be able to connect to the Curricular Competencies of the History and Genocide Studies course to visiting the sites where historical events have occurred. Highlighting some of the connections in Genocide Studies 12 that are learned experientially would be;

- Acts of violence and atrocities in different global regions
- Evidence to demonstrate the scale and nature of Genocide
- Assessing the significance of location and events

Travelers' will be building a deep understanding that history does not simply occur in textbooks. Walking in the place of Genocide and History deepens their connection to their place in the world. Their experiences will be connected back to the curricular content in the courses via dialogue both on the trip and upon the return in the classroom. The impact of their experiences will undoubtedly be shared with fellow students at Kwalikum Secondary to expand the influence of the understanding on Genocide.
