

Why a New Running Track?

The existing track was built in the last century with a red cinder base. Apart from some improved drainage and re-cindering, no major upgrades have been made since 1977.

The existing facility is past the end of life. The track has no curbs and therefore merges with the grass infield on the inside and the outfield on its outside. The track is full of weeds which makes it dangerous to run on. Lane markings are not permanent. Drainage is a major issue and the track regularly develops holes and dips, which require continual maintenance, which in turn adds to the unevenness of the surface.

The track was identified by the community as needing to be replaced in 2005 and has been the subject of numerous studies over the years.

The Vision

- Six lane competition level rubberized track (with 8 lane 100m).
- Funding of \$1.5 million to be closed by spring 2022.
- Construction will begin as soon as the funding target is reached.
- Fully accessible.
- Prepared for temporary bleachers as needed.
- A free regional amenity used by 30,000 people of the Oceanside region and 4,200 students.
- Inclusive to all ages and all abilities.
- Measurable health effects for our citizens.
- Bookable for events, suitable for competition.
- An agreed joint-use partnership through RDN.
- Funding and plans in place for upgrades over time.



The Benefits for Oceanside

There is a clear region-wide consensus around community benefits of a new community track:

- Our youth will develop a life-long love of healthy activity.
- Our seniors and senior clubs (such as PGOSA) can continue to participate in an active lifestyle.
- Our athletes will have a place to train and develop in the Oceanside area.
- Our Pre-school, Primary, High School and Further Education students will have a safe and quality track to use.
- Our schools will be able to expand outdoor education and hold sporting events such as the annual Oceanside Sport Day.
- A quality track will ensure a positive first experience for those trying Track and Field for the first time, encouraging a life-long love of sport, fitness and wellbeing.
- Our local sports teams from across the area will have a facility to train and excel.
- Those in rehabilitation will have a safe environment to rebuild their health.
- Families will have a place to keep fit together and also help vary the activities of their children, increasing their love of the outdoors.
- Those with accessibility limitations will be able to participate in a safe and inviting venue.
- ...And who knows, maybe more Oceanside Olympic and Paralympic athletes will represent Team Canada.

What Investment is Needed?

The renewal of the track will cost \$1.5 million to construct and maintain for twenty years. This estimate includes such work as excavation, hauling, fill, removing of existing curb, leveling, drainage, paving, curbing, line painting, landscaping, seeding, synthetic surfacing, retaining walls and fencing.

Should additional funds be raised, they would be used to assist with ongoing maintenance and any necessary upgrades and/or repairs to the track.
